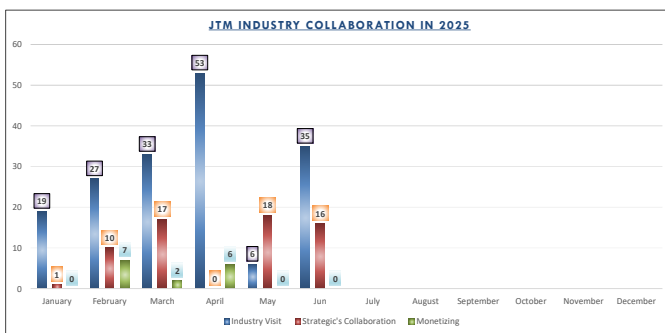

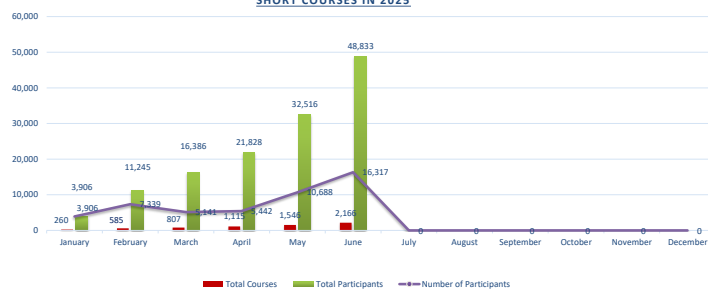

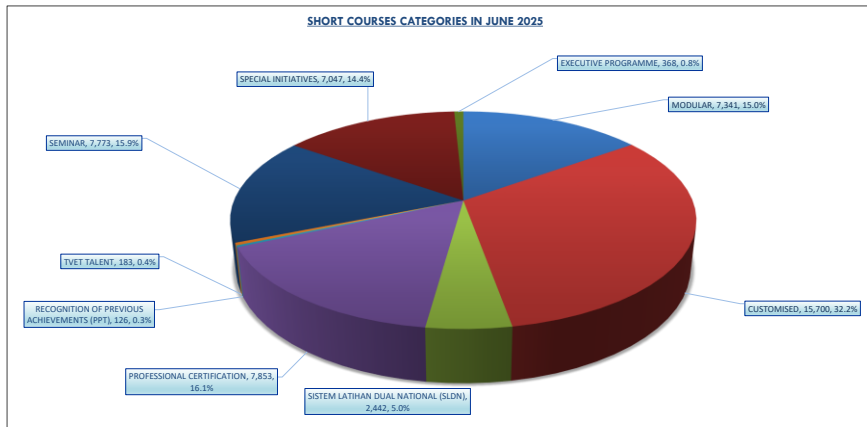

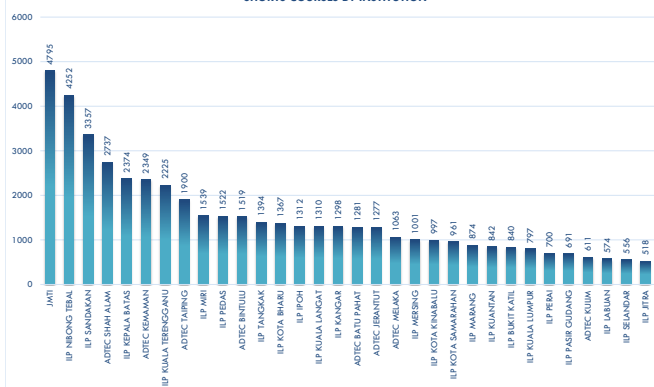

SHORT COURSES CATEGORIES IN JUNE 2025



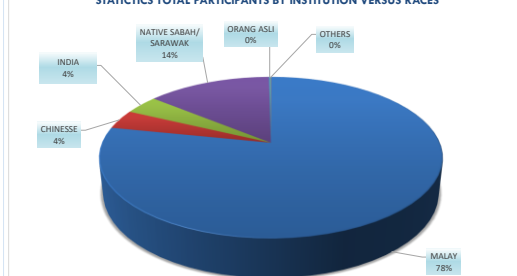

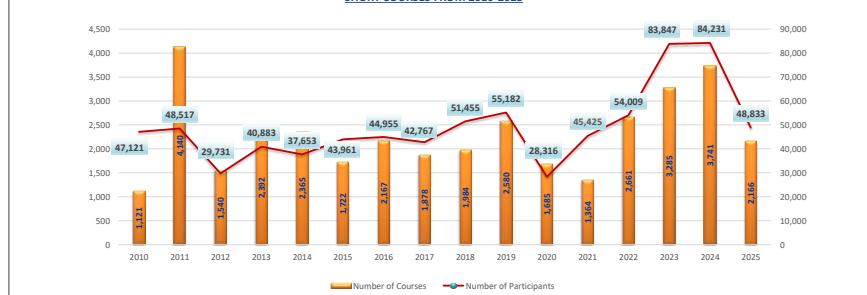
STATISTICS TOTAL PARTICIPANTS BY INSTITUTION VERSUS RACES

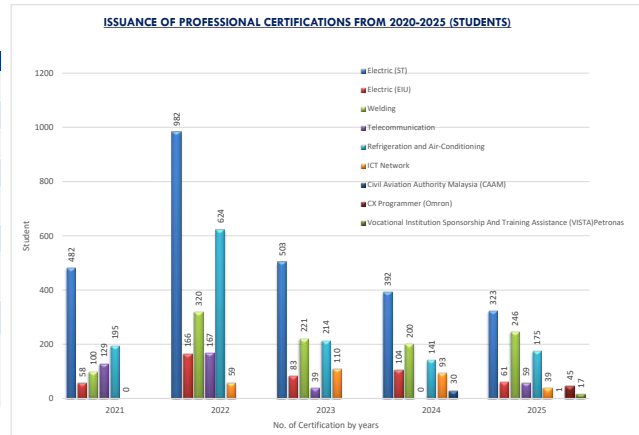

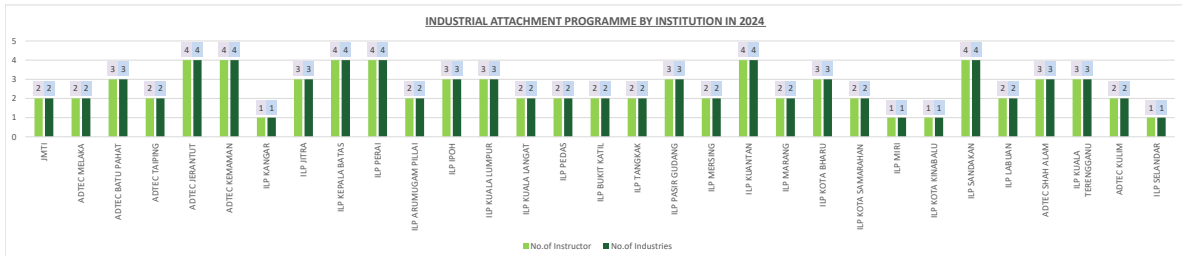
